## GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL DEGREES

- 1. Writing Proficiency ("W"):** Basic writing proficiency is required of all students. Any course with a "W" suffix (for example: COMM 103W) may be used to satisfy this requirement. Students must also complete the advanced writing proficiency requirements of their majors.
- 2. Foreign Language Requirement:** Two semesters of the same language at the appropriate level are required unless exempted by examination (or majoring in medical technology). For more information please see **PART II**, Modern Languages and the *Saint Mary's College Bulletin*, under Modern Languages.
- 3. Distribution Requirements:** Each Student must complete the distribution requirements for the degree she is seeking. **No more than two courses in any one discipline may be used to satisfy the following requirements.** See Part II for specific course that fulfill these requirements
